

Tyre packaging instructions

Shipping vehicle tyres with PostNord services

- Shipping vehicle tyres within the PostNord network always requires a separate agreement and compliance with these packaging instructions.
- The following pages contain examples of approved and non-approved packaging methods.
- A shipment containing multiple car tires can only be sent on a pallet. Always also note the service-specific maximum dimensions and weights.
- Shipping tyres is not possible with all of our services, because due to fire safety regulations, tires cannot be stored at pickup points.
- If home delivery of the tyres is not possible, the tyres are always returned to the terminal, not to a pickup point.

Example of recommended packaging – straps cross-tied



- Cut the edge of the cardboard to align with the tire
- Tape or staple the cardboard in place so that other items do not catch on the edge of the cardboard and damage it.
- Strap the package tightly.
- Cross-strapping is especially important.

Example of recommended packaging – cable tie



The picture shows the solid side.

- Cut a slot in the package in the middle so that it is attached to the tyre.
- Make a similar slot on the opposite side.
- Tighten the strap firmly through the slots around the package.
- Strap crosswise.

Example of recommended packaging – strapping band



The image shows the open side.

- Cut a groove in the edge of the cardboard for the strap to match the tyre.
- Fold the excess cardboard over for protection.
- Make a similar groove on both sides.
- Tighten the band firmly around the package through the grooves.
- Cross-strapping is important as well in this packaging method.

Example of recommended packaging – packed in a plastic bag



- Cut off any excess plastic.
- Attach the address card to a flat surface.
- These instructions apply to tyres only.

Example of a recommended packaging method – shrink wrap



- Attach the address label to a flat surface.

Not permitted packaging methods



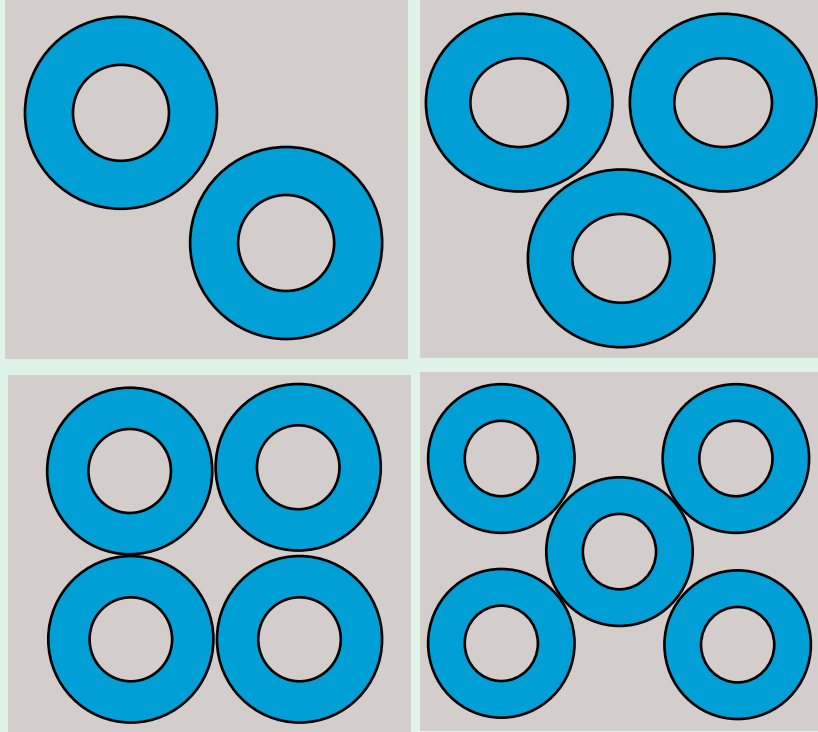
Tyres must not be sent unpackaged.

Examples of not approved packaging



Unpacked, incorrectly packed or insufficiently packed tyres will be returned to the sender.

Sending multiple tyres



For shipments with multiple tyres, the tyres must be placed on a of suitable size pallet.

Tyres must be secured to the pallet with straps as shown, and additionally wrap with stretch film.

Tyre Pallets:

- Use a sufficiently large pallet, the tyres must not extend beyond the pallet edges.
- Wrap the tyres in stretch film and place protector made of strong cardboard, plastic, or wood on the top.
- Secure the stack of tyres to the pallet with strong plastic or metal straps.
- When using different tyre sizes, place the largest on the bottom and the smaller ones on top.

Tyres for two-wheeled vehicles

Tyres for two-wheeled motor vehicles (motorcycles, mopeds)
You may send two tyres packed together in a cardboard box.



Not permitted packaging methods



When sending multiple tyres, the tyres must be placed wrapped in stretch film on a suitable sized pallet.

Tyres must not be sent unpacked.
